**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On April 7, 2020, in response to the national COVID-19 emergency, Spire Missouri, Inc. (Spire) filed a tariff and motion for expedited treatment. Spire asks to devote approximately \$940,000 of funding to customers financially impacted by COVID-19. Spire will partner with United Way to screen customers for eligibility in order to provide those eligible customers a one-time monetary credit to their accounts.

The tariff bears an effective date of May 7, 2020. However, Spire asks that the tariff become effective no later than April 17, 2020.

The Commission will order Staff to file a Recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or alternative pleading no later than April 10, 2020.
2. Any other party who wishes to respond shall do so no later than April 10, 2020.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
