ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

In its Order Approving ISRS Rates, issued on October 23, 2008, the Commission authorized Atmos Energy Corporation to file a tariff implementing an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge sufficient to recover appropriate pre-tax revenues in the amount of \$408,181. Atmos issued the required tariff on October 27, with a 30-day effective date of November 26. Along with its tariff, Atmos submitted a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff to become effective on November 4.

Staff filed its recommendation regarding Atmos' tariff on October 28. Staff indicates the tariff complies with the Commission's Order, and recommends the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on November 4. No other party has filed a recommendation.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines the tariff complies with the Commission's Order. The Commission also finds good cause to

approve the tariff to be effective in less than 30 days. The Commission will approve the tariff effective November 4.
