ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On May 2, 2011,¹ Laclede Gas Company (hereafter "Laclede") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2007, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. Section 393.1015.2(3) requires the Commission to act on the application no later than 120 days after it was filed. That means the Commission must issue an order regarding the application effective no later than August 30.

Along with its application, Laclede filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge.

Unless the Commission suspends that tariff, it will become effective on July 8.

So that it can consider Laclede's implementing tariff and the underlying application, that tariff shall be suspended until August 30, unless sooner approved by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed by Laclede Gas Company, on May 2, 2011, and assigned tariff number YG-2011-0556, is suspended until August 30, 2011. The tariff suspended is:
