**KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S STATUS REPORT, AND MOTION
FOR CANCELLATION OF THE ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION**

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L or the Company) and, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080, respectfully provides its Status Report to the Commission, and Motion For Cancellation of On-the-Record Presentation. In support of its Status Report and motion, the Company states as follows:

1. On November 30, 2004, the Commission issued its Order Setting Second On-The-Record Conference ("Order") which scheduled an on-the-record conference for December 22, 2004, "for Kansas City Power & Light, the Staff of the Commission, and other parties to provide an update on the status of this case." (Order, p. 1)
2. The purpose of this pleading is to provide an update on the status of this case, and request that the On-The-Record Conference scheduled for December 22, 2004, be cancelled.
3. The discussions among the parties have been productive, but are not yet completed. These discussions have included issues related to KCPL's capacity needs for the future, capital investments related to compliance with environmental regulations, infrastructure investments, and customer programs, as well as the likely impact of these investments and programs upon KCPL's future revenue requirements. KCPL continues

to be optimistic that these discussions will result in an amicable resolution of most, if not all, of the issues being discussed. However, at this point in time, KCPL, Staff, Public Counsel and the other participants will need additional time to discuss these matters.

4. Having provided the Commission with an update on the status of this proceeding, KCPL would respectfully request that the On-The-Record Conference scheduled for December 22, 2004, be cancelled. Cancellation of this conference will avoid the need for KCPL, Staff, Public Counsel, and other participants to appear in person in Jefferson City during the week before the Christmas holidays.

5. Staff, Public Counsel and the other participants that have been represented by counsel in this proceeding have been apprised of this motion, and no one has expressed any opposition to the cancellation of the On-The-Record Conference scheduled for December 22, 2004. KCPL would suggest that the On-The-Record Conference be re-scheduled for a time on or about January 18, 2005.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, KCPL respectfully requests that the Commission accept KCPL's Status Report, and cancel the On-The-Record Conference scheduled for December 22, 2004.
