Stipulation And Agreement that addresses all the issues in this matter, the Parties respectfully request that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule in this matter.

3. The Parties support the filing of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule in this matter to allow for the finalizing and filing of a Stipulation And Agreement that recommends a resolution of all issues in this case.
