JOINT REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") (collectively, the "Company"), by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby files its Joint Revised Procedural Schedule.

1. On November 19, 2015, the Commission issued its *Fourth Order Granting Motion for Extension of Time to File Stipulation and Agreement and Procedural Schedule* which ordered KCP&L and GMO to file a joint revised procedural schedule no later than November 30, 2015.

2. On November 23, 2015, the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff"), KCP&L, GMO, the Office of the Public Counsel, National Housing Trust, West Side Housing Organization, Natural Resources Defense Council, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy ("DE") and United for Missouri, Inc. filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation"). Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC") indicated no opposition to the Stipulation.

3. On November 30, 2015 Brightergy, LLC ("Brightergy") filed its Objection to the Stipulation. Brightergy takes issue with only two aspects of the Stipulation: 1) the level of

incentives in the Business Efficiency Rebate – Custom, and 2) the ability of the Company to discontinue all approved programs during MEEIA Cycle 2.

4. The Company requests that the Commission revise the procedural schedule as follows:

Hearing	January 12, 2016
Initial Brief	January 29, 2016

5. Staff, Brightergy, MIEC, DE and Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri have indicated that they either support or will not oppose this Joint Revised Procedural Schedule. All of the remaining parties to the above-captioned matters have been apprised of the contents of this Joint Revised Procedural Schedule and have not indicated their position.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission accept its Joint Revised Procedural Schedule as set forth above.
