## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO REPORT

In its July 24, 2009 order approving a unanimous stipulation and agreement, the Commission allowed Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri to stop automatically delivering a copy of its white page residential directory to each of its customers in Missouri's metropolitan areas. In that same order, the Commission directed AT&T to file a report describing its efforts to encourage and facilitate the recycling of old telephone directories. As ordered, AT&T filed its report on September 1.

If, after reviewing AT&T's report, the Commission's Staff, or any other party, would like to offer comments or suggestions about that report, it shall do so no later than September 21, 2009.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party that wishes to respond to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Report Concerning Telephone Book Recycling shall do so no later than September 21, 2009.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
