For their errata the Applicants state as follows:

1. On March 9, 2018, Advanced Energy Management Alliance (“AEMA”) filed its Recommendations on Distributed Energy Resources in Missouri (“AEMA Comments”) in this docket.

2. On March 28, 2018, the Company filed its Response to the AEMA Comments. After filing, the Company noted a typographical error which needs to be corrected, as follows:

- i. Exhibit A, p. 1 of 2. In the third line of the second paragraph under the heading *History and Progress of KCP&L’s Demand Response Program*, there is an incorrect reference to “35,00 smart thermostats,” which should instead read “35,000 smart thermostats”
