**ORDER APPROVING PGA TARIFF**

Issue Date: May 30, 2018

Effective Date: June 1, 2018

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff<sup>1</sup> to reflect changes in Ameren Missouri's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) as a result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas. For Ameren Missouri's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, the tariff filing will decrease from 56.00¢ per hundred cubic feet (Ccf) to 48.00¢/Ccf for firm sales customers; decrease from 32.69¢ per Ccf to 27.30¢ per Ccf for the interruptible sales customers; decrease by \$0.08 per Ccf for General Service customers; and decrease by \$0.0539 per Ccf for interruptible sales customers. Additionally, the proposed PGA factor applicable to Ameren Missouri's Rolla system will decrease the PGA factor for firm sales customers from 76.00¢ per Ccf to 67.00¢ per Ccf; for interruptible sales customers from 33.94¢ per Ccf to 28.55¢ per Ccf; for General Service customers by \$0.09 per Ccf; and a decrease of \$0.0539 per Ccf for interruptible sales customers. The tariff sheets bear a proposed effective date of June 1, 2018.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its verified recommendation on May 23, 2018. Staff recommended approving the tariff on an

interim basis, subject to refund, pending final decisions with regard to the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) account balance in this file and in the 2016-2017 ACA file, GR-2017-0341. No responses to the Staff recommendation were received.

Based on the verified filings, the Commission will approve the tariff as Staff recommends. Further, because Ameren Missouri's tariff provides for PGA change filings to take effect on 10 days' notice, the Commission finds good cause for the tariff sheets to become effective on less than 30 days' notice.<sup>2</sup>

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The tariff assigned Tracking No. JG-2018-0156 is approved, on an interim basis and subject to refund, to become effective on June 1, 2018.
2. This order shall become effective on June 1, 2018.
