## ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITED TREATMENT AND OVERTURNING NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION

On November 23, 2010, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc. AT&T Missouri's application requested one block of one-thousand numbers in the 636 NPA within the Harvester, Missouri rate center, and an XXXX of either 6XXX or 7XXX. The additional numbers are needed in order to meet the needs of RGA Reinsurance Company.

On November 29, 2010, the Staff of the Commission filed its Staff Recommendation. No other applications to intervene, requests for hearing, or recommendations have been filed. Staff explained that AT&T Missouri does not have the telephone numbers needed to meet this customer's needs. Staff believes AT&T Missouri has demonstrated a verifiable need for one block of one-thousand numbers in the 636 NPA within the Harvester, Missouri rate center, and an XXXX of either 6XXX or 7XXX. Staff recommended the Commission grant AT&T Missouri's request.

The Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from a carrier pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g)(4), which states in part, "The state commission also may overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies."

Based on AT&T Missouri's application and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T Missouri has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. The Commission overturns NANPA's decision and approves AT&T Missouri's request for one block of one-thousand telephone numbers as listed above.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Motion for Expedited Treatment is granted.

2. The North American Numbering Plan Administrator's decision to withhold numbering resources from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, is overturned.

3. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri's request to receive one block of one-thousand numbers in the 636 NPA within the Harvester, Missouri rate center, and an XXXX of either 6XXX or 7XXX, is granted.

4. This order shall become effective on December 5, 2010.
