JOINT RECOMMENDATION OF THE PARTIES

Renew Missouri, Ameren Missouri, Empire District Electric Co., KCP&L and KCP&L-GMO, PSC Staff, MIEC have agreed to the following procedures and schedule.

- 1. The parties agree that an evidentiary hearing is not necessary. The issues are legal in nature and can be resolved by the filing of comments and oral argument.
- 2. With the consent of the other parties, Renew Missouri agrees to waive its comments on "Environmental Impact" as to the 2011 compliance plan filings only, and in accordance with the Responses to Renew Missouri's comments filed by MDNR, including the requirement that certification applies to both utility-owned facilities and facilities for which the utility has a contract for the acquisition of renewable energy resources.

3. The parties agree that there is sufficient overlap of issues that all the remaining issues can be addressed in a single unitary proceeding. The issues and the companies to which each applies are:

• Solar exemption: Empire District;

• Qualifying hydro: Ameren, Empire District;

• REC banking: Ameren, KCP&L, KCP&L-GMO.

4. The parties agree to the following procedural schedule:

• August 11: Any additional responses to Renew Missouri's comments;

August 22: Renew Missouri's reply;

as the resolution to the issues discussed herein.

• August 31 at 1:00 p.m.: Oral argument before the Commission.
