ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On March 29, 2016, Alliance Connect, LLC, filed a letter informing the Commission that it is changing the name under which it provides telecommunications service in Missouri to Aureon Communications, LLC. The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation regarding Alliance Connect's notice by April 13.

On April 12, Staff filed a request for extension, explaining that Alliance Connect has not yet filed all the documents needed to complete its name change application. Staff asks for an indefinite extension of its obligation to file a recommendation, indicating it will file that recommendation after Alliance Connect files the required document.

The Commission will grant an extension, but will not make that extension indefinite. Instead, the Commission will grant Staff a one-month extension so that it can be kept informed of developments in the case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's request for extension is granted.

- 2. No later than May 13, 2016, Staff shall file either its recommendation regarding Alliance Connect, LLC's notice, or its explanation of why a recommendation cannot be filed at that time.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
