**ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION TO EXTEND**  
**FILING DEADLINE FOR PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On September 23, 2005, Time Warner Cable filed tariff P.S.C. Mo. No. 3 to replace its P.S.C. Mo. Nos. 1 and 2. The tariff sheets bear an effective date of October 23, 2005.

On October 18, the Commission suspended the tariffs, and ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 3. The Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Extend Filing Deadline for Proposed Procedural Schedule on November 3. In that motion, Staff explained that it was preparing a response to Time Warner Cable's Motion to Reconsider Suspension of Tariff, and asked the Commission for an extension until November 10 to file a proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Extend Filing Deadline for Proposed Procedural Schedule is granted.

2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 10, 2005. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for a hearing.

3. That this order shall become effective on November 4, 2005.
