On July 23, 2020,¹ the parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement (agreement), and the Commission issued its Order Suspending Procedural Orders and Cancelling Evidentiary Hearing. On September 29, the Complainant filed a Request for Ruling on Stipulation. On October 1, the Commission issued its order requiring the parties to identify what parts if any of the agreement they wanted deemed confidential and to state why. They have complied with the order, have agreed that those parts of the agreement identifying homeowners' names, addresses, and home serial numbers will be treated as confidential pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.135(2)(A)1, and have agreed Complainant will provide the Commission with a version of the agreement with the confidential information redacted. The Commission will order the Complainant to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than October 14, 2020, the Complainant shall file a copy of the parties' agreement with all parts redacted that identify homeowners' names, addresses, and home serial numbers.
