2 JUDGE WOODUFF: All right. We're in-camera.
3 And I -- I believe everyone in the room works for the --
4 for the Director, so I don't believe anyone has to leave,
5 other than the Attorney General, and I don't know that --
6 Mr. Harrison, do you care if the Attorney General's aware
7 of this?

8 MR. DELINE: I don't care.

9 MR. HARRISON: We don't care.

10 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Can you tell us who
11 the identity of the buyer is?

12 MR. HARRISON: It's a company called Baytree
13 Investments. They're based in Chicago. They call
14 themselves a merchant bank. I don't know. I don't know
15 what -- what other information you want. For that matter,
16 I'm not sure what information I have. Maybe Mr. DeLine
17 has some, but that's answers the basic question.

18 JUDGE WOODUFF: Okay. Can you give us an
19 address?

20 MR. HARRISON: I can't. I can't as I sit here.
21 I certainly could do it after the hearing is over. I
22 can't do it as I sit here, no.

23 JUDGE WOODUFF: Okay.

24 MR. HARRISON: I don't have it with me.

25 JUDGE WOODUFF: And can you make a filing with

1 that information later?

2 MR. HARRISON: Sure.

3 JUDGE WOODUFF: And, Mr. Reed, is the Director
4 already aware of this information?

5 MR. PLEUS: No. I --

6 MR. REED: I don't think we knew.

7 MR. PLEUS: I've heard the name, but that's all
8 -- yes. Mr. DeLine gave me that information.

9 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay.

10 MR. HARRISON: Is there anything else you want
11 to know?

12 MR. REED: I don't --

13 MR. HARRISON: We can talk after the fact --
14 after the hearing here or something. We're -- I think
15 we're fairly agreeable to disclose what you want to know.

16 MR. REED: Yeah. I think we'll -- we have the
17 name. We'll get the address, and we'll find out what we
18 can. Beyond that, I can't think of anything.

19 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay.

20 MR. HARRISON: All right.

21 JUDGE WOODRUF: Commissioner Clayton, did you
22 have any other questions about the identify of the -- of
23 the purchaser?

24 COMMISSIONER CLAYTON: No. I really don't have
25 any questions about that. I'm going to have to rely on

1 our Staff to give us guidance on any problems or issues
2 that arise from that. I don't have any additional
3 questions.

4 JUDGE WOODUFF: All right. Well, earlier, I
5 asked you to make a filing. I don't know if it's
6 necessary. I'll leave it to Staff after -- after you've
7 made your investigation. If there's something that you
8 want to bring to the attention of the Commission, I'll ask
9 Staff to make that filing. And, of course, that can be
10 filed as highly confidential.

11 MR. HARRISON: Okay. All right. That's fine.

12 JUDGE WOODUFF: Okay. I don't believe there's
13 anything else about that that needs to be on -- in-camera.
14 So at this time, we'll come out of the in-camera session.
