25 days?

1 MS. BRETZ: A week is fine.

2 JUDGE GRAHAM: A week. All right. Okay. At
3 that point I'll ask are there any other issues that need
4 to be addressed?

5 Hearing none, we're going to go off the record
6 at this point. Thank you very much, Mr. Brady. I
7 appreciate getting ahold of you.
