## ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO OPEN CASE FOR INVESTIGATION OF A NATURAL GAS INCIDENT

Issue Date: July 12, 2007 Effective Date: July 12, 2007

On July 2, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a request with the Commission to open a case to investigate an incident that occurred on May 25, 2007 in Kansas City, Missouri. In its request, Staff states that Missouri Gas Energy employees were injured when a gas pipe, over which the employees were excavating, heaved from the ground propelling debris. Staff adds that it will file a final report or an update 120 days of the Commission opening a case.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's request and, finding it reasonable, will open a case for investigation into the gas incident.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Case No. GS-2008-0002 is established for the purpose of conducting an investigation into the incident which occurred on May 25, 2007 in Kansas City, Missouri.
- 2. The Staff of the Commission shall file either a final report or an update no later than November 9, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on July 12, 2007.
