**APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION**

800 Response Information Services LLC (“Applicant” or “Company”), a Vermont limited liability company, files this verified Application respectfully requesting the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a Certificate of Service Authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392 RSMo;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant and Applicant’s requested services;
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Sections 392.420; and
- (d) approves Applicant’s proposed tariff.

In support of its request, Applicant states:

1. Applicant is Vermont limited liability company with its principal place of business at 200 Church Street, Burlington, Vermont 05401. Applicant is authorized by the Missouri Secretary of State’s Office to do business in Missouri. A copy of Applicant’s Certificate of Registration with the Missouri Secretary of State is attached as Exhibit A.

3. Applicant's statutory representation in the State of Missouri is:

4. Through this Application, Applicant proposes to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services throughout the state of Missouri. Specifically, Applicant seeks authority to provide resold inbound toll-free "800" services to business customers seven days a week on a twenty-four hour a day basis.

5. A copy of Applicant's proposed tariff showing at least a forty-five (45) day effective date is being filed simultaneously with this Application.

6. Applicant requests that it and all of its services proposed herein be classified as competitive. Applicant believes that the highly developed state of the interexchange telecommunications services market in Missouri and nationwide ensures that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to warrant a less rigorous degree of regulation.

7. As a new market entrant, Applicant requests streamlined regulatory treatment afforded similarly situated telecommunications carriers in Missouri.

Likewise, to the extent the Commission has granted other competitive interexchange carriers waiver of certain of the Commissions rules and regulation, Applicant respectfully requests that it be granted the same waivers.

8. Consistent with the Commission’s treatment of other certificated telecommunications companies, Applicant respectfully requests that, pursuant to sections 392.361 and 392.420 RSMo, the following statutes and regulations be waived with respect to its interexchange service offerings:

- §392.210.2 - Uniform system of accounts
- §392.240(1) - Rates
- §392-270 - Valuation of property
- §392.280 - Depreciation accounts
- §392.290 - Issuance of securities
- §392.300.2 - Acquisition of stock
- §392.310 - Issuance of stock and debt
- §392.320 - Stock dividends
- §392.330 - Issuance of securities, debts and note
- §392.340 - Reorganizations

Rules

- 4 CSR 240-10.020 - Depreciation fund income
- 4 CSR 240-30.040 - Uniform systems of accounts
- 4 CSR 240-32.303(2) - Records kept within state

9. Applicant will comply fully with all applicable Commission rules except those that are specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to the Company’s request herein. To the extent that the Commission may modify its waiver policies, Applicant respectfully reserves the right to amend its waiver requests accordingly.

10. Applicant does not have any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which

involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three years of the date of this Application.

11. Applicant will not unjustly discriminate among its customers, which discrimination is prohibited pursuant to Section 392-200 RSMo.

12. No Commission annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

13. Applicant is financially capable of providing the services proposed.


Applicant also possesses the necessary technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes to offer at standards that will meet or exceed all service standards established by the Commission.

14. Applicant submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this Application because Applicant's proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this Application will also expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

WHEREFORE, 800 Response Information Services LLC respectfully requests that the Commission: (1) grant it a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri; (2) grant Applicant and its proposed services competitive status; (3) waive the application of the above-referenced statutes and Commission rules; and (4) approve its tariffs upon submission.






