¹The St. Joseph Area Public Water Supply Districts primarily focused on the issue of maintaining Single Tariff Pricing ("STP") as the appropriate rate design to be utilized in this proceeding. However, as noted in our Reply Brief, the record reveals that Staff's total revenue deficiency after true-up, at the mid-point of Staff's proposed return on equity, is \$10,709,595. (Tr. 1980). This results in a total increase of approximately 33 per cent. (Tr. 1980). It is our understanding that this figure may be reduced in the actual reconciliation which Staff is filing (\$10,488,812 before phase-in and uncollectibles), and the Water Districts would support such a reduced amount.

As stated in the Water Districts' Briefs filed in this matter, while willing to support mechanisms that will lessen the significant rate shock that will result to the Water Districts and their customers in this case, the Water Districts have expressed concern that the rate phase-in proposals may add significant carrying costs to the final rate increase approved over time. Therefore, while no phase-in is depicted in this scenario, a minimal phase-in period may be appropriate, depending on the magnitude of the approved rate increase.

²These amounts reflect the monthly rate that customers will be paying one year from today, assuming an approximate 33 % across the board increase. As the Water Districts have advocated, any rate increase authorized should be spread on an across-the-board basis throughout the Company's existing rate schedule, with no inter-class shifts of revenue being made in this case. As noted in Footnote 1, the actual amount of Staff's total revenue deficiency (before phase-in and uncollectibles) may be reduced in the reconciliation filed this date and, accordingly, the percentage increase may be reduced. The above-amounts for Average Monthly Usage and Monthly Bill Present Rates are derived from "Table 3-B" of Exhibit 10: Rebuttal Testimony of William M. Stout on behalf of Company.
