4. For these reasons and to make a full and a fair record, the OPC requests the Commission to order as follows:

- a. That within 7 or fewer days from the filing of a Commission order granting the OPC's request, Staff or Ameren Missouri may provide affidavit(s) that would constitute a factual basis as the foundation of their agreement. Such affidavit(s) could not be filed, could be directive by pointing to other pre-filed testimony, or could be supplemental in nature for any new positions, and in addition or in the alternative;
- b. That within 7 days of the filing of any Ameren Missouri affidavit(s) or Staff affidavit(s), OPC and any other non-signatory party would be permitted to file supplemental testimony in opposition or in support of the non-unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and any accompanying affidavit(s).

WHEREFORE, the OPC request the Commission modify this procedural schedule with the conditions set forth herein.
