**ORDER OVERTURNING NORTH AMERICAN  
NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION**

Effective Date: January 25, 2008

On December 18, 2007, Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC filed an application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., of Charter's application to obtain an additional code of 10,000 telephone numbers in the Wentzville Rate Center, to offer and support local telecommunications services in the Wentzville rate center.

On January 11, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed its Staff Recommendation. No other applications to intervene, requests for hearing, or recommendations have been filed. Staff recommended the Commission grant Charter's request for one code of 10,000 telephone numbers in the Wentzville Rate Center to designate for the MCA-related numbers. Staff stated Charter will return 9,000 of the telephone numbers back to the pool within 30 days.

The Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from a carrier pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g)(4), which states in part, "The state commission also may overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies."

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Charter has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. The Commission overturns NANPA's decision and approves Charter's requests for one code of ten-thousand telephone numbers as listed above.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The North American Numbering Plan Administrator's decision to withhold numbering resources from Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC is overturned.
2. Charter's request to receive one code of ten thousand telephone numbers in the Wentzville Rate Center, is granted.
3. Charter shall return 9,000 of the telephone numbers back to the pool within 30 days of the effective date of this order.
4. This order shall become effective on January 25, 2008.

5. This case may be closed on January 26, 2008.
