ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS

On April 25, 2008, Laclede Gas Company filed an application and petition to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS). The Commission established May 19 as the deadline for interested parties to file an application to intervene.

A group of large industrial customers of Laclede, calling themselves the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), filed an application to intervene on May 19. More than ten days have passed since MIEC filed its application to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that MIEC's interest in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.
