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A: My name is Mark Baker and I am currently New Madrid County

Commissioner. This is my 4th year in office. I won the

August primary election and face no opposition in November.

Therefore, in January 2009 I will start a second term in that position.

Q: IN NEW MADRID COUNTY DO THEY HAVE JUST A SINGLE COMMISSIONER OR IS IT SEVERAL PERSONS ON A BOARD?

A: There are three commissioners. There is one from the south end of the County, District 2, and there is one from the north end of the County, District 1, which is what I am, and then we have a commissioner that is over the whole County -- that is elected by the whole county, the Presiding Commissioner.

Three all together.

Q: I AM AN OLD MISSOURIAN. IS THIS WHAT WE USED TO CALL THE COUNTY COURT?

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A: Yes. County Court, County Judges, yes, those were the names for them.

Q: COMMISSIONER BAKER, WHAT DO YOU DO FOR A LIVING BESIDES BEING COMMISSIONER?

A: I am a farmer as my main line of work.

Q: COMMISSIONER BAKER, ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH NORANDA ALUMINUM?

11 A: Yes, I am.

Q: WHAT DO YOU THINK ABOUT THE PLANT AND ABOUT HOW THE PEOPLE THERE OPERATE IT AND SO ON?

A: I think the plant is vital to not only New Madrid, but to New Madrid County and southeast Missouri as a whole. I think there's about 1,100 people that work there, I am not sure of exactly the number, but 1,100 - 1,200. I know some of those people live right here in New Madrid City, New Madrid County, but also every County in the Boot Heel and I am sure there are a few out of state as well. Noranda is a vital employer for southeast Missouri.

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1	Q:	HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE NORANDA AS A CORPORATE CITIZEN IN THE
2		LARGER COMMUNITY?

4	A:	I think Noranda is a good corporate citizen. I know that every
5		cause worthy causes or whatever you might call it
6		approaches Noranda about funding or donations. I don't know
7		what the policy is, but I know they fund lots of activities
8		not only in New Madrid but also Sikeston and other communities
9		in the Boot Heel.

11	Q:	FROM ALL OF THAT I TAKE IT THAT YOU BELIEVE IT WOULD BE
12		IMPORTANT TO YOU AS A PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVE, A PUBLIC
13		OFFICIAL, THAT NORANDA CONTINUE ITS OPERATIONS THERE IN THE
14		SOUTHEASTERN PART OF THE STATE?

16	A:	Yes. It is absolutely vital that Noranda be there as an
17		employer in this part of the state. I couldn't even begin to
18		imagine the effect that not having Noranda or losing Noranda
19		would have on the economy for several communities in our area.

21	Q:	HAS BEING A COUNTY COMMISSIONER GIVEN YOU A DIFFERENT
22		PERSPECTIVE ABOUT NORANDA THAN YOUR PREVIOUS POSITION OF NEW
23		MADRID MAYOR?

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Well, I would say it does because one of the biggest concerns as a commissioner is the budget that we have to operate our County government off of. That is derived from several sources but mostly sales tax and property tax. I would hate to think about losing Noranda and the revenue that is generated due to Noranda being in this area. Especially the County and the County government - not to mention the payrolls that are taken home by all those employees and the number of dollars that money represents as far as how many times those dollars turn over in our economy in the Boot Heel. Noranda has 21% of the county's total assessed value for 2007.

Noranda also paid \$3,285,002.46 in county tax in tax year 2007.
