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**RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY
SUSPENSION OF SCHEDULING ORDER**

COMES NOW Respondent, Wightman Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Lee's Mobile Homes, by and through undersigned counsel, and for its request for a temporary suspension of the scheduling order, states as follows:

1. Respondent is now the owner of the manufactured home at issue in this case.
2. The parties are currently proceeding under a scheduling order.
3. The Office of the Director is conducting an investigation regarding ownership of the manufactured home.
4. It is Respondent's understanding that if the Office of the Director determines that the Respondent is in fact the owner of the manufactured home at issue in this case, then the Director will dismiss the case.
5. In light of the foregoing, Respondent requests that the scheduling order be temporarily suspended for a period of ten days in order for the Office of the Director to complete its investigation regarding the ownership of the manufactured home.
6. Counsel for the Director, Bruce Bates, has indicated that he does not oppose a temporary suspension of the scheduling order.

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests that the Commission suspend the scheduling order for a period of ten days, and for such other and further relief that the Commission deems just and proper.
