On August 23, 2005, Sprint Nextel Corporation filed an application requesting that the Commission approve the transfer of control of Sprint Missouri, Inc., Sprint Long Distance, Inc., and Sprint Payphone Services, Inc. from Sprint Nextel Corporation to LTD Holding Company. As a result of this transfer, Sprint's wireline local service operation will be separated into an independent, stand-alone operation.
