- JUDGE WOODRUFF: This is the pre-hearing
- 3 conference in Case No. IO-2008-0092 which involves the
- 4 review of the competitive classification of the
- 5 exchanges of Embarq Missouri.
- 6 And we'll begin today by taking entries of
- 7 appearance beginning with Embarq.
- 8 MR. ZARLING: Thank you, Your Honor, my
- 9 name is Kevin K. Zarling representing Embarq Missouri,
- 10 Inc. My business address is 400 West 15th Street,
- 11 Suite 1400, Austin, Texas 78701.
- 12 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for Staff.
- 13 MR. HAAS: Good afternoon, William K. Haas
- 14 appearing on behalf of the Staff of the Public Service
- 15 Commission. My address is Post Office Box 360,
- 16 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for Public Counsel.
- MR. DANDINO: Thank you, Your Honor,
- 19 Michael Dandino, Deputy Public Counsel, Office of
- 20 Public Counsel, Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City,
- 21 Missouri 60102, representing the Office of Public
- 22 Counsel and the public.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: And I believe that's all
- 24 the parties.
- The reason I called this pre-hearing conference

- 1 was to give the parties a chance to discuss how we
- 2 need to proceed in this case.
- 3 As you know, we are going to be having a hearing.
- 4 And I'll ask the parties at this point; do we
- 5 anticipate doing pre-file testimony, or is this
- 6 something we can do as a live hearing?
- 7 MR. DANDINO: We had a discussion last
- 8 Friday trying to kind of go through this. And I think
- 9 what we are going to try to do is at least kind of
- 10 follow what's going on in -- what is it -- CenturyTel,
- 11 and kind of see if we can at least stipulate to some
- 12 of the facts, or if that is -- at least in our office
- 13 file some testimony with a very brief hearing, more to
- 14 the nature of a question and answer.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay.
- MR. DANDINO: If that goes with what a few
- 17 of the other counsel say.
- 18 JUDGE WOODRUFF: I'm open to any ideas
- 19 you'll have.
- 20 Mr. Zarling, what is Embarq's position?
- 21 MR. ZARLING: We have discussed this last
- 22 week, and that will work for Embarq, too.
- 23 Probably the only question is timing, and I know
- 24 that Mr. Haas has to talk to Staff to see what works
- 25 for them, so let him weigh in.

1 MR. HAAS: Yes, we had discussed the
```

- 2 procedure, and we hope to follow the same procedure
- 3 that was followed in the CenturyTel case.
- And I guess once we get off the record we can
- 5 discuss calendar.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. That's fine.
- 7 I assume we are probably looking at after the
- 8 holidays?
- 9 MR. DANDINO: Yes.
- 10 MR. ZARLING: Yes.
- MR. HAAS: Yes.
- 12 JUDGE WOODRUFF: That's fine. I'll leave
- 13 you to discussions and ask you to file something by
- 14 Friday of this week -- the 14th -- letting me know
- 15 what your proposal is, and I'll take a look at it.
- 16 And if it looks acceptable to me, I'll issue an order
- 17 implementing it.
- 18 MR. HAAS: Your Honor, since we are looking
- 19 at January, can we have until next Monday? I'm going
- 20 to be out of the office Thursday and Friday.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: That's fine, the 17th
- 22 then.
- MR. ZARLING: You know, Judge, just to try
- 24 and avoid too much back and forth -- and one of the
- 25 counsel will interject if I'm getting ahead of

- 1 ourselves here a little bit -- but we had discussed
- 2 tentatively some dates, you know, weeks that we would
- 3 look at in January possibly for a hearing.
- 4 So, if you have any idea what the Commission's
- 5 availability is? We had talked about, I think, the
- 6 third week of January, January 14th maybe, we might
- 7 have proposed to have a hearing.
- 8 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Mr. Haas, have you checked
- 9 on the calendar upstairs on that?
- 10 MR. HAAS: No, I haven't.
- 11 JUDGE WOODRUFF: I haven't either. I don't
- 12 think there's anything particularly exciting going on
- 13 in January. Although, I know the Aquila/KCPL merger
- 14 is going to be back on in January some time, but I
- don't know that that's been set yet.
- MR. ZARLING: Well, then I think, Counsel,
- 17 we'll just exchange e-mails or reconvene and try to
- 18 nail down dates. I hope we can figure out when the
- 19 Commission is available. I guess Mr. Haas has access
- 20 to that information?
- 21 JUDGE WOODRUFF: It's all up on the board.
- 22 Well, anything else anyone wants to bring up while
- 23 we are on the record?
- MR. DANDINO: No, I think we are good.
- 25 JUDGE WOODRUFF: With that then, we are off
