On December 21, 2007, Chariton Valley Telephone Corp. (Chariton) applied for modifications of local number portability and dialing parity obligations for indirectly interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol providers. On September 25, Chariton filed a notice dismissing its application.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits an applicant to voluntarily dismiss its application without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered. No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that Chariton has dismissed its application.
