**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF PETITION FOR ARBITRATION,
ADDING A PARTY, AND DIRECTING RESPONSE**

On December 17, 2009, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission a petition for arbitration pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, requesting that the Commission arbitrate unresolved issues AT&T has with Global Crossing Local Service, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement Inc.¹

As Global Crossing is a party to the agreement, the Commission finds that it is necessary and indispensable to a resolution of this matter and shall be made a party. The Commission will direct the Data Center to provide notice of this petition to Global Crossing and Global Crossing will be permitted to file a response to the petition with any additional information it chooses to provide.

The Commission informs the parties that confidential information is governed by Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.135.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center shall serve notice of this petition upon Global Crossing Local Service, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement Inc.
2. Global Crossing Local Service, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement Inc. are made parties to this matter.
3. Global Crossing Local Service, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement Inc. shall file a response, and any additional information regarding the petition for arbitration, no later than January 11, 2010, with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, with a copy to:
