ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND PETITION

On January 6, 2010, the Missouri Public Service Commission dismissed this matter for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. On January 13, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an Application for Reconsideration and/or Rehearing and Alternative Motion for Leave to Amend the Petition by Interlineation.

As directed, on January 19, Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. filed a response to AT&T's application for reconsideration. Global takes no position with regard to the Commission reconsidering its dismissal. However, Global does support AT&T's request to amend its application.

The Commission will allow AT&T to supplement its application. In its application for rehearing, AT&T asserts that its June 11, 2009, letter to Global was not a request to negotiate; rather, that Global requested negotiation on July 11. In supplementing its petition, the Commission will require AT&T to therefore file documentary¹ evidence of Global's request to negotiate.

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri shall file, no later than January 22, 2010, documentation of Global Crossing Local Service, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc.'s request for negotiation of the interconnection agreement.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
