## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING RECOMMENDATIONS

Issue Date: January 6, 2010 Effective Date: January 6, 2010

This order directs that notice of this case be sent to all certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene and for the filing of recommendations.

On January 5, 2010, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application and Motion for Expedited Treatment under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., to withhold certain numbering resources from AT&T Missouri. AT&T Missouri requested one block of one thousand numbers from which 400 consecutive numbers may be drawn which are within (1) the 816 Numbering Plan Area (NPA); (2) the Lee's Summit rate center; (3) the 607 NXX; and (4) the XXXX range of one of the following: 2000-2999, 3000-3999, 4000-4999, or 7000-7999. The numbering resources are needed in order to meet the

needs of the State of Missouri's office located at 600 NE Colbern Road in Lee's Summit,

Missouri

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. Therefore, the Commission will set a time for interventions as directed below. The Commission will also direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.
- 2. Any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than January 15, 2010, with:

- 3. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding AT&T Missouri's application, or shall file a status report indicating when a recommendation will be filed, no later than January 15, 2010.
- 4. Any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding the application of AT&T Missouri, shall do so no later than January 15, 2010, and shall file its recommendation simultaneously with its application to intervene.
  - 5. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
