

**JOINT MOTION TO SUSPEND FILING
OF PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COME NOW ALLTEL Missouri, Inc. (ALLTEL), the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") (collectively "the Parties"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.090(6), and for their Motion to Suspend Filing of Proposed Procedural Schedule respectfully state as follows:

1. On June 21, 2002, the Commission issued its Order Setting Prehearing Conference and Requiring Filing of Procedural Schedule in this matter, which scheduled a Prehearing Conference on July 1, 2002, and ordered that the parties jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than July 8, 2002.

2. The Parties appeared and participated at the Prehearing Conference held on July 1 and, as a result of discussions regarding both procedural and substantive matters in this and other pending Commission proceedings¹, agree that the filing of a proposed procedural schedule in this matter should be suspended for sixty (60) days, until September 6, 2002. No party will be prejudiced by such suspension.






