

To Whom It May Concern:

I have been instructed by the Louisiana, Missouri City Council to file a formal complaint with the Missouri Public Commission concerning construction work performed by AT&T.


AT&T operates and maintains telephone lines which was formally operated by Southwester Bell, in Louisiana, Missouri. Construction crews authorized by AT&T excavated four pits in the spring of 2006 in Louisiana along Business 54. These holes are still open and are poorly maintained. AT&T is not diligently working on this project. I would estimate that AT&T has not had staff at these sites over two percent of the time period since opening these excavations.

Citizens have also raised concerns over the safety surrounding these areas. Of course you have the natural hazard normally associated with an open pit with a poorly maintained poly fence. In my estimate, an even greater danger exists because AT&T does not properly maintain the vegetation inside of the excavation areas, sight lines for motorist have been greatly impaired. Many "near misses" have been reported because of grass and weeds being rarely or never cut in a growing season.

We have had dialogue with AT&T but were presented with promises which were not fulfilled (please see attached). We understand that some issues can come up in the middle of construction projects but after twenty plus months for this small of a project, we have run out of understanding and patience.
