JOINT APPLICATION AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COME NOW Warren County Water & Sewer Company, Warren-Lincoln Investments, Inc. d/b/a Warren County Water & Sewer, and Gary Smith and A. Lynn Smith (individually and collectively "Warren County"); and, Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), and, pursuant to Section 393.190, RSMo 2000 and 4 CSR 240-3.605, state the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as their Joint Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

1. MAWC is a Missouri corporation with its principal office and place of business at 535 N. New Ballas Road, St. Louis, Missouri 63141. MAWC is a Missouri corporation in good standing. A Certificate of Good Standing from the Office of the Missouri Secretary of State was filed in Commission Case No. WM-2001-309 and is hereby incorporated by reference in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G). MAWC currently provides water service to the public in and around the cities of St. Joseph, Joplin, Brunswick, Mexico, Warrensburg, Parkville, Riverside, Jefferson City, and parts of St. Charles and Platte Counties Missouri, and most all of St. Louis County, Missouri. MAWC currently provides water service to approximately 445,000 customers. MAWC provides sewer service to approximately 100 customers near Parkville,

Missouri. MAWC is a "water corporation," a "sewer corporation" and a "public utility" as those terms are defined in Section 386.020 RSMo. 2000, and is subject to the jurisdiction and supervision of the Commission as provided by law. MAWC currently has a general rate case pending appeal (WR-2000-281) and a general rate case pending before the Commission (WR-2003-0500). MAWC has no overdue Commission annual reports or assessment fees.

- 2. Warren County Water & Sewer Company is a Missouri corporation and holder of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from the Commission to operate water and sewer utilities in certain areas of Warren, Lincoln and St. Charles Counties, Missouri. Warren County Water & Sewer Company has forfeited its charter to the State of Missouri for administrative deficiencies. The entity thus operates at this time under a registered fictitious name, the ownership of the Corporation's assets being designated by Missouri Law applicable to corporations that have forfeited their charters. All of the stock and all of the assets of the Warren County Water & Sewer Company are thus owned or controlled by Gary Smith, A. Lynn Smith, Warren County Water & Sewer Company or Warren-Lincoln Investments, Inc., also a Missouri Corporation. All of the common stock of Warren County Water & Sewer Company and Warren-Lincoln Investments, Inc. is owned by A. Lynn Smith and Gary Smith.
- 3. Warren County has a principal office and place of business located at 1248 Mimosa Court, Foristell, Missouri 63348. As stated above, Warren County Water & Sewer Company cannot produce a Certificate of Good Standing.

THE TRANSACTION

- 5. MAWC and Warren County have entered into a Contract For Sale of Water Distribution System Assets and Sanitary Sewer Systems Assets of the Warren County Water & Sewer Company to Missouri-American Water Company dated September 2, 2003 ("Agreement"), a copy of which will be marked Appendix A and late-filed with the Commission. Pursuant to the Agreement, MAWC proposes to obtain and acquire certain assets of Warren County as specifically described in the Agreement under the terms and provisions further described in the Agreement. Such assets include the Warren County certificates of convenience and necessity as reflected in Commission Case Nos. WM-93-109 and WA-96-449. The Agreement is not included as it is considered by the applicants to be highly confidential in nature. It will be late-filed with the Commission upon the issuance of the Commission's standard protective order.
- 6. Because Warren County is a water corporation and sewer corporation doing business in the State of Missouri, it is subject to the provisions of Section 393.190.1, RSMo 2000, which states, in pertinent part, that "no . . . water corporation or sewer corporation shall hereafter sell, assign, lease, transfer, mortgage or otherwise dispose of or encumber the whole or any part of its franchise, works or system, necessary or useful in the performance of its duties to the public . . . without having first secured from the Commission an order authorizing it so to do."

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 7. A certified copy of the resolutions of the Board of Directors of MAWC and Warren County authorizing the purchase and sale, respectively, of the subject assets and related transactions contemplated by the Agreement are marked <u>Appendix B</u>, attached hereto, and made a part hereof for all purposes.
- 8. A balance sheet and income statement with adjustments showing the results of the acquisition of the property for MAWC is marked **Appendix C**, attached hereto, and made a part hereof for all purposes.
- 9. The sale of assets should have no impact on the tax revenues of relevant political subdivisions as both MAWC and Warren County are both private entities.

PUBLIC INTEREST

- 10. For the following reasons, the proposed acquisition of the specified assets of Warren County and the related transactions are not detrimental to the public interest of the State of Missouri and in fact will be consistent with and will promote the public interest.
- 11. The assets of Warren County would be acquired by MAWC, a Missouri public utility, and remain subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission. MAWC has considerable expertise and experience in providing water and sewer utility services to residents of the State of Missouri.
- 12. MAWC is fully qualified, in all respects, to own and operate the systems currently being operated by Warren County and to otherwise provide safe, reliable and affordable service. MAWC will continue to utilize the rates, rules and regulations and other tariffs currently on file with and approved by the Commission and will continue to operate under those rates, rules and regulations until such time as they may be modified according to law.
 - 13. In order to protect the interests of both MAWC and the customers of Warren County,

MAWC seeks an order/agreement as follows:

- A. That the rates existing at the time MAWC acquires the assets will continue in effect until the operation of law date associated with MAWC's next general rate filing after May 1, 2004, and/or thereafter, until changed as a result of a Commission Order. Except as provided in subsection B below, neither MAWC, the Commission Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") will before May 1, 2004 file a case to change the rates in effect at the time of this acquisition.
- B. Neither MAWC, the Commission Staff nor the OPC may file a general rate increase case or a general rate decrease case before May 1, 2004 to change the Warren County rates, unless a significant, unusual event that has major impact on the Warren County operating district occurs, such as:
 - (i) terrorist activity or an act of God;
 - (ii) a significant change in federal or state tax laws;
 - (iii) a significant change in federal or state utility laws or regulations; or,
 - (iv) an unexpected extended outage or shutdown of the Warren County water supply or sewer service.
- C. Nothing herein shall prohibit rate filings concerning MAWC's operating districts other than Warren County.
- 14. The customers of Warren County should over time experience an improvement in the quality of their day-to-day utility service.
- 15. The acquisition of the subject assets by MAWC will improve the ability of these properties to attract capital required to undertake and complete additions, improvements and replacements to its facilities necessary for it to meet the needs of its customers and to satisfy environmental requirements.

RATEMAKING TREATMENT

16. MAWC seeks an order/agreement that the assets that are the subject of this application will be valued for ratemaking purposes at the purchase price contained in the Agreement.

MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

17. MAWC and Warren County seek to complete this transaction by October 31, 2003, in order to bring to a close, as soon as possible, the proceedings continuing before the Circuit Court of Warren County. Therefore, MAWC and Warren County move the Commission to expedite its processing such that the transaction contemplated by the Agreement can be consummated no later than October 31, 2003.

WHEREFORE, MAWC and Warren County respectfully request that the Commission expedite the processing of this application such that the transaction contemplated by the Agreement can be consummated no later than October 31, 2003, and thereafter issue its order:

- (A) authorizing MAWC to acquire the assets identified herein of Warren County;
- (B) authorizing MAWC to enter into, execute and perform in accordance with the terms described in the Agreement attached to this Joint Application and to take any and all other actions which may be reasonably necessary and incidental to the performance of the acquisition; and,
- (C) granting such other relief as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to accomplish the purposes of the Agreement and the Joint Application and to consummate related transactions in accordance with the Agreement.


