JOINT APPLICATION

COME NOW The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) and Ozark Electric Cooperative (Ozark), hereinafter referred to collectively as "Applicants," and for their Joint Application, pursuant to Section 394.315, RSMo (2000), 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.140, respectfully state as follows:

APPLICANTS

1. Empire is a Kansas corporation with its principal office and place of business at 602 Joplin Street, Joplin, Missouri 64801. Empire is engaged in the business of providing electrical and water utility services in Missouri to customers in its service areas. Empire is an "electrical corporation," a "water corporation," and a "public utility" as those terms are defined in § 386.020 RSMo. 2000, and is subject to the jurisdiction and supervision of the Commission as provided by law. Empire has no pending or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or its rates, which have occurred within the three years immediately preceding the filing of this Joint Application. Empire has no overdue Commission annual reports or assessment fees. Empire's documents of incorporation have been previously filed with the Commission in Case No. EF-94-39, and said documents are incorporated herein by reference in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G). A Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State to the effect that Empire, a foreign corporation, is duly authorized to do business in the State of Missouri was filed with the

Commission in Case No. EM-2000-369, and is incorporated herein by reference.

- 2. Ozark is a rural electric cooperative organized and existing under the laws of Missouri with its principal office at 10943 North Highway 39, Mount Vernon, Missouri 65712. It is a Chapter 394 rural electric cooperative corporation engaged in the distribution of electric energy and service to its members within certain Missouri Counties. Ozark has no pending or final judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court that involve its customer service or rates within the three years immediately preceding the filing of this Joint Application. A copy of a Certificate of Good Standing from the Office of the Missouri Secretary of State for Ozark is attached hereto and marked **Appendix A**.

FACTS

- 4. Ozark currently provides electrical service to Rick and Debra Tucker, located at 5055 North Highway NN, Ozark, Missouri 65721, and to Willard Kissee at 5053 and 5075 North Highway NN, Ozark, Missouri 65721. These properties are served through four meters and consist of one residential dwelling, a closed restaurant and a car sales lot. Ozark serves the properties through a single-phase overhead line that extends from the properties to the intersection of Highway NN and Highway J.
 - 5. A developer has requested that Ozark relocate the existing line that provides

service to the Tucker and Kissee properties in order to facilitate development of adjacent property. The structures now served by Ozark are located within an area that has been annexed into the City of Ozark. Pursuant to Missouri law, Ozark may not provide service to new structures within the annexed area. Rather than pay the cost of relocation to enable development, one of the customers (Kissee) and the developer (Sheer) have agreed to pay Ozark the reasonable cost of retirement of the existing facilities in favor of new service by Empire. Ozark has determined that it is acceptable and prudent to agree to retire and remove its segment of distribution line that hinders development and that has no potential for gaining additional utilization. In order to provide service to the existing structures, Empire will be required to construct a 7.2 kV overhead electric line extension that will be 460 feet in length. It is therefore proposed that the Commission approve a change of supplier for the Tucker and Kissee properties that will allow Ozark to discontinue service and allow Empire to provide service to those properties.

- 6. A diagram of the properties, Ozark's existing line and Empire's proposed line is attached hereto and marked **Appendix B**. All relevant properties are located within the city limits of the City of Ozark, Missouri. Empire is authorized to serve the City of Ozark, Missouri.
- 7. Mr. Kissee and Mr. and Mrs. Tucker have consented to the proposed change of supplier from Ozark to Empire. Their written consents are attached hereto as **Appendix C** and **Appendix D**, respectively.

STATUTE

8. Section 394.315.2, RSMo provides in relevant part that "[t]he public service commission, upon application made by an affected party, may order a change of suppliers on the basis that it is in the public interest for a reason other than rate differential, and the commission

is hereby given jurisdiction over rural electric cooperatives to accomplish the purpose of this section."

PUBLIC INTEREST

9. The proposed change of supplier is in the public interest because it will allow Ozark to remove an existing power line in order to aid development within the City of Ozark. There will be no need to reconstruct that same line, because Empire has available facilities in reasonably close proximity to the subject customers. Development will be aided in the most efficient manner possible by allowing this proposed change of electric supplier. The change also achieves operational efficiencies for the electric suppliers and reduces utility duplication. Thus, the proposed change of supplier is in the public interest for a reason other than a rate differential.

WHEREFORE, Joint Applicants respectfully request that the Commission issue its order:

- (a) Finding that the change of electric supplier proposed herein is in the public interest and approving the proposed change of electric supplier; and
- (b) Granting such other relief as is deemed necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Joint Application.


