**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE
TO WITHDRAW FROM REPRESENTATION**

On December 24, 2009, Mary Ann (Garr) Young filed the above-reference motion. Ms. Young stated that she is leaving the private practice of law to accept other employment, and thus needs to withdraw her representation of Constellation NewEnergy-Gas Division, LLC ("Constellation"). Ms. Young states that William D. Steinmeier will continue to represent Constellation; thus, it will not suffer any harm.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party has objected to the motion.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(6) allows an attorney to withdraw from a case before the Commission only by leave of the Commission. In light of Constellation having legal representation other than Ms. Young, and in light of no party objecting to Ms. Young's motion, the Commission will grant Ms. Young leave to withdraw.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Leave to Withdraw From Representation filed by Mary Ann (Garr) Young is granted.

2. Mary Ann (Garr) Young shall be removed from the service list.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
