

In the Matter of the Cancellation of the Certificate) **File No. LD-2016-0227**
And Tariff of Nextlink Wireless, LLC) Tracking No. YL-2012-0753

On March 22, 2016, Staff filed its recommendation, stating that Nextlink did not offer or provide telecommunication services and no longer wished to retain its certification to provide telecommunications services in Missouri. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide telecommunications services and its accompanying tariff.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Nextlink’s request and Staff’s recommendation, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Nextlink Wireless, LLC, shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide competitive local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services granted to Nextlink Wireless, LLC, in File Number TA-2006-0267, is canceled.
2. Nextlink Wireless, LLC’s tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1 is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on April 7, 2016.
4. This case may be closed on April 8, 2016.
