

The agent signed below has not sent in favorable business word information today.

I do think the current sitting P.S.C. Group in the state have a somewhat out of control with A.T. & T. Corp who sends telephone billing and taxes upon their customers for the 911 System and all establish and started by Missouri local city and town union Police Departments.

all of above scheme are now followed up by current Liberty utilities natural gas asking by a filing for P.S.C. rate increase presently of \$6.3m for an unspecified customer rate increase which P.S.C. should not be allowed to approve for this present sitting P.S.C.

The following reasons the P.S.C. should not approve a \$6.3m increase are, the financing and accounting terms are not clear to residential customers, the infrastructure of the gas company is not clear to the residential customers, the paying customers are presently in doubt of the burdened economy, all operating business have an expense and profit risk, and a business may borrow bank loans or other loans, and business may place its firm and all assets up for sale, if it is not satisfied with the operation.

The proposal rate increase of \$6.3m made in February 6, 2014 if allowed will impact a severe burden upon the hard working residential customers in the state, if the Missouri P.S.C. approve another rate increase of \$6.3m.
