LIBERTY UTILITIES' RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("Liberty" or "Company") and, pursuant to the Commission's *Order Setting Deadline For Filing* issued in this matter on December 9, 2015, states its response to the Staff Recommendation Regarding Liberty Utilities' 2013-2014 Actual Cost Adjustment Filing ("Staff Recommendation")¹ filed December 4, 2015, as follows:

As noted in the Staff Recommendation, Liberty filed its Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA") for the 2013-2014 period in this case on November 4, 2014, setting forth Liberty's ACA account balance calculation. The Staff Recommendation follows Staff's audit and analysis of Liberty's filing. The Staff's audit consisted of a review and analysis of the billed revenues and natural gas costs for the period of September 1, 2013, to August 31, 2014, for all areas served by the Company in Missouri.

LIBERTY'S RESPONSE TO ACA ACCOUNT BALANCES RECOMMENDED BY STAFF

Based on its review, Staff recommended the following adjustments to the Company's filed (over)/under-recovered ACA balances:

LIBERTY'S RESPONSE TO STAFF TECHNICAL REPORT AND ANALYSIS

I. BILLED REVENUE AND ACTUAL GAS COSTS

Compliance Adjustments

At pages 3 through 6 of the Staff Memorandum, Staff describes "several compliance adjustments proposed by Staff as a result of misstated or missing entries in the Company's filing. These adjustments affect all service areas." As noted in this section, the Company acknowledged certain inadvertent errors in its filing and, accordingly, accepts these monetary compliance adjustments. In its discussion of "Monthly Cash-out Provisions — Transportation Customers" at page 6 of the Staff Memorandum, Staff concludes that it has no cash-out adjustments in this ACA review. Liberty notes that this subject was addressed in its prior ACA review (File No. GR-2014-0060), wherein Staff described efforts to "clarify" previous applicable tariff language. Indeed, in order to clarify the terms of its tariffs, Liberty agreed to modified tariff language that was ultimately contained in its compliance tariffs filed and approved in its most recent general rate case, Case No. GR-2014-0152.

II. RELIABILITY ANALYSIS AND GAS SUPPLY PLANNING

A. Peak Day Planning

In the Staff Memorandum, pages 6-9, Staff stated its recommendations regarding Peak Day Planning, and specifically recommended on page 7:
