**ORDER RECOGNIZING NOTICE TO  
REMOVE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS**

On October 27, 2010, Falcon Cablevision, a California Limited Partnership, d/b/a Charter Communications, (“Charter”) filed notices informing the Commission of the discontinuance of service in the following political subdivisions:

<b>Political Subdivision</b>
City of Harrisonville
El Dorado Springs
Nevada
Vernon County

The City of Harrisonville has been transferred to CoBridge Broadband, LLC, d/b/a CoBridge Communications. The remaining three subdivisions listed above have been transferred to CoBridge Telecom, LLC. Both companies have video service authorizations in effect for their respective political subdivisions.

The Commission has reviewed the notices filed by Charter and finds that in accordance with Section 67.2685, RSMo Cumm. Supp. 2009, the video service authorization for the above-listed political subdivision has expired and shall be removed from Charter’s video franchise service area.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Falcon Cablevision, a California Limited Partnership, d/b/a Charter Communications' video service authorization is amended by the removal of video service in the above-listed political subdivisions.
2. This Order shall become effective on November 26, 2010.
3. This case may be closed on November 26, 2010.
