

ROCK PORT TELEPHONE COMPANY d/b/a ROCK PORT LONG DISTANCE'S  
CONCURRENCE IN STAFF'S MOTION TO CLARIFY ORDER

Comes now Rock Port Telephone Company d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance ("RPLD")  
and for its Concurrence in Staff's Motion to Clarify Order states to the Missouri Public Service  
Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1. On April 18, 2000, RPLD and Fiber Four Corporation ("FFC") filed a Joint  
Application requesting a certificate of service authority for RPLD to provide interexchange and  
non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the exchanges served by Rock Port  
Telephone Company and for authority to transfer a portion of the assets of FFC necessary to the  
provision of interexchange services to these customers from FFC to RPLD.

2. On June 20, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Approving Interexchange and  
Non-Switched Local Exchange Certificates of Service Authority, Order Approving Tariff, and  
Order Approving Transfer of Assets and Cancellation of Certificate granting the relief requested  
in the Joint Application. This Order was made effective June 30, 2000.

3. On June 21, Staff filed a Motion to Clarify Order in which it asked the Commission to clarify its Order to make clear that the certificate of service authority issued in this case grants the authority to Rock Port Telephone Company d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance and that the services classified as competitive are only those Rock Port Telephone Company is to provide under the d/b/a "Rock Port Long Distance."

4. RPLD concurs in this Motion to Clarify Order filed by Staff in that it was RPLD's intent in filing the Joint Application to only provide interexchange services through the d/b/a "Rock Port Long Distance" and to request that only the services provided by RPLD be classified as competitive services.

5. RPLD files this concurrence so that the Commission may know that it has no objection to the entry of a clarification order to this effect and also to request that the effective date of the original order not be changed so that RPLD may proceed with its plans to transfer the assets and begin providing service to these customers as of July 1, 2000.

Wherefore, RPLD respectfully requests that the Commission grant the Staff's Motion to Clarify Order so that the certificate of service authority is granted to "Rock Port Telephone Company d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance" and that the telecommunications services classified as competitive are only those Rock Port Telephone Company is to provide under the d/b/a "Rock Port Long Distance."

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
