Establish a Briefing Schedule states as follows:

1. The hearings in this matter were held on September 4, 1998. At the  
conclusion of the hearings, a briefing schedule was not established because Southwestern  
Bell's Motion to Strike, which if granted would affect the scope of the case, was still  
pending. Accordingly, the Parties recommended that the briefing schedule be tied to the  
date on which the Commission ruled upon Southwestern Bell's motion. The proposal at  
the hearing was that initial briefs be due thirty (30) days after an Order on the Motion to  
Strike and Reply Briefs twenty (20) days thereafter. The Motion to Strike has not been  
ruled on and no briefing schedule has been set.

2. Southwestern Bell requests that the Commission establish the following  
briefing schedule:


Simultaneous Initial Briefs January 6, 1999
