2. Other than cases that have been docketed at the Commission, MGE has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments against it from any state or federal agency or court within the past three (3) years that involve customer service. MGE has no annual report or assessment fees that are overdue. MGE currently conducts business as a “gas corporation” and

provides natural gas service to approximately 500,000 customers in the Missouri counties of Andrew, Barry, Barton, Bates, Buchanan, Carroll, Cass, Cedar, Christian, Clay, Clinton, Dade, Dekalb, Greene, Henry, Howard, Jackson, Jasper, Johnson, Lafayette, Lawrence, McDonald, Moniteau, Pettis, Platte, Ray, Saline, Stone, and Vernon, subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission as provided by law.

3. MGE's activities are the primary focus of the following open cases pending before the Commission: GR-2003-0330, GR-2006-0066, GR-2005-0104 and GR-2001-382.

4. MGE previously requested an extension of its annual report filing from April 15, 2006, to May 15, 2006, based upon delays associated with the completion of MGE's annual audit. The Commission acknowledged that extension by electronic mail on March 31, 2006.


5. MGE continues to experience delays with the completion of its annual audit and the completion of its Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Form 2, which constitutes the biggest part of the Gas Annual Report. These delays are due to logistical challenges associated with the relocation of the corporate reporting function to Houston in the fourth quarter of 2005.

6. Completion of the Missouri Gas Annual Report is not possible until MGE has completed both the annual audit and the FERC Form 2. It now appears that these processes will not be completed until approximately June 15, 2006.

7. MGE believes that its Annual Report can then be filed with the Commission by June 30, 2006.

WHEREFORE, for the good cause shown above, MGE requests the Commission to grant its Application to Extend Time for Filing of Annual Report, and allow MGE until June 30, 2006, to file its Gas Annual Report.






