4. On December 22, 2008 Missouri Gas Utility, Inc. ("MGU") filed its application which is the

subject of the above-captioned case. By its application, MGU proposes to install a natural

gas distribution system to provide sales and transportation service in Bolivar and Buffalo,

Missouri. To provide this service, MGU seeks an area certificate as well as a line certificate.

5. By the Commission's Corrected Notice and Order issued December 28, 2009, the

Commission established an intervention deadline of January 12, 2010.

6. MGE should be allowed to intervene in this proceeding because it has an interest that is

different from that of the "general public" which may be adversely affected by a final order in

this case. According to the application, the area for which MGU seeks a line certificate runs

adjacent to the present service territory of MGE. Additionally, the application states that a

proposed pipeline will cross MGE's natural gas distribution lines. MGE is still analyzing the

impact of the proposals outlined in the application as well as any other potential conflicts

with its service territory and facilities.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated herein, MGE respectfully requests that the Commission

issue an order permitting it to intervene in this case with full rights as a party hereto.
