Re: Mid MO Sanitation LLC
Request for Increase in Annual Sewer Operating Revenues

Secretary –

Mid MO Sanitation LLC (“Mid MO” or “Company”) is engaged in the provision of sewer service pursuant to a certificate of convenience and necessity issued by this Commission in Case No. SA-2009-0319. The Company currently has 30 residential customers and 4 commercial customers.

Mid MO’s rates were last set effective July 1, 2009. On February 1, 2015, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) issued a new wastewater discharge permit for Lake Breeze Estates, which is served by Mid MO. That permit established a compliance schedule requiring Mid MO to design and build a suitable system that would remove nearly all ammonia from the wastewater before being allowed to be discharged to the Waters of the State. An Engineering Facility Plan was prepared and submitted to MDNR. The Plan examined various treatment options. The best, most affordable option was a "no discharge - land application system." That option has since been approved, constructed and placed into service. Mid MO now seeks to adjust its rates after consideration of this investment.

Accordingly, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075 (Staff Assisted Rate Case Procedure), Mid MO hereby requests an increase in annual sewer system operating revenues in the amount of approximately \$22,000. The Company understands that the design of its customer rates, its service charges, its customer service practices, its general business practices and its general tariff provisions will also be reviewed during the Commission Staff’s

review of the rate increase request and may thus be the subject of Staff recommendations at the conclusion of the rate increase process.

Mid MO is in good standing with the Missouri Secretary of State and has no annual report, annual statement of operating revenues, or assessment fees that are overdue.
