PROPOSED LIST OF ISSUES, ORDER OF WITNESSES, ORDER OF CROSS-EXAMINATION AND ORDER OF OPENING STATEMENTS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), on behalf of all other parties to this case, and submits the following Proposed List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross-Examination, and Order of Opening Statements for the evidentiary hearing to be held in this case January 24-26, 2001.

- 1. This case was established pursuant to the Report and Order that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued on June 10, 1999, in Case No. TO-99-254.
- 2. The Commission thereafter permitted various parties to intervene and subsequently granted the requests of certain parties for leave to withdraw from the case. The list of parties who remain in this case includes the Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), and the following intervenors: Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT"), the Missouri Independent Telephone Group, f/k/a Mid-Missouri Group ("MITG"), Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Sprint ("Sprint"), Sprint Communications Company, L.P. ("Sprint, LP"), the Small Telephone Company Group ("STCG"), GTE Midwest Incorporated, d/b/a Verizon Midwest ("Verizon"), Fidelity Telephone Company ("Fidelity"), TCG St. Louis, Inc. ("TCG St. Louis"), and TCG Kansas City, Inc. ("TCG Kansas City").

- 3. On October 10, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Establishing Procedural Schedule. The said Order directed the parties to agree upon and the Staff to file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, and the order in which the witnesses shall be called, and the order of cross-examination of each witness. The said Order directed the Staff to file the List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination by no later than January 17, 2001.
- 4. The parties have conferred and have unanimously identified the following list of contested issues, although not all agree every identified issue is a proper subject for decision by the Commission in this case. The parties have unanimously agreed upon the following order of witnesses, order of cross-examination, and order of opening statements.

I. LIST OF CONTESTED ISSUES

The parties have agreed upon the following list of contested issues:

- 1. Signaling Protocols. Is it necessary for the Commission to decide in this case what signaling protocols should be utilized for intrastate intraLATA traffic terminating over the common trunks between the former PTCs and the former SCs?
- 2. Traffic Measurement. How and where should intrastate intraLATA traffic terminating over the common trunks between the former PTCs and the former SCs be measured for purposes of terminating compensation?
- 3. Call Records. What call records should be utilized for intrastate intraLATA traffic terminating over the common trunks between the former PTCs and the former SCs?
- 4. Trunking Arrangements. What changes, if any, should be made to the existing common trunking arrangements between the former PTCs and the former SCs?

- 5. Business Relationships. What business relationship should be utilized for payment for intrastate intraLATA traffic terminating over the common trunks between the former PTCs and the former SCs?
- 6. Call Blocking. What procedure or arrangement, if any, should be utilized to prevent noncompensated intrastate intraLATA traffic from continuing to terminate over the common trunks between the former PTCs and the former SCs?
