STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On November 18, 2009, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) for approval of an Amendment to an Interconnection Agreement (Amendment) by and between AT&T Missouri and New Cingular Wireless PSC, LLC (Cingular) under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2. Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 provides that a State Commission may only reject a negotiated agreement (or any portion thereof) if it finds that the agreement (or any portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement (or portion) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, Staff states that the amendment to interconnection agreement does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement and is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission approve the amended interconnection agreement pursuant to the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
