**MCLEODUSA'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW TARIFF FILINGS**

**COMES NOW** McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc., (McLeodUSA), by and through undersigned counsel, and for its Motion to Withdraw Tariff Filings, states that on March 3, 2004, McLeodUSA filed revised tariff pages designed to revise its local exchange tariff in several respects, including adding an Account Handling Charge to its local service tariff (P.S.C. MO No. 4, Tariff No. JC-2004-1048), and separately filed an interexchange tariff revision designed solely to add an Account Handling Charge to its interexchange tariff (P.S.C. MO No. 5, Tariff No. JX-2004-1049). On April 1, 2004, the Commission issued Orders suspending the tariffs, opening the above-referenced cases, and on April 5, 2004, issued a Notice of Correction in CT-2004-0497.

The Commission issued an Order consolidating these cases on April 13, 2004, and set a prehearing conference regarding the consolidated matters. The prehearing conference took place as scheduled on April 19. The parties to the case were unable to determine an approach that would have a high degree of likelihood of resolving concerns of the Commission with the language describing the proposed Account Handling Charge, and McLeodUSA understands that the Commission would not entertain a proposal to withdraw only the pages

addressing the Account Handling Charge from the local exchange tariff filing; therefore, McLeodUSA has determined that it wishes to withdraw both tariff filings in their entirety. Because McLeodUSA intends to refile the portions of the local exchange tariff (P.S.C. MO No. 4) that appear to be non-controversial, and cannot do so during the pendency of this matter due to the prohibition against “pancaking” tariff filings, McLeodUSA requests that the Commission grant this Motion at its earliest convenience.

Wherefore, McLeodUSA respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Withdraw the tariff filings which are the subject of these cases in their entirety, at the Commission’s earliest convenience.
