Mr. Taylor,

The Missouri Department of Conservation was unable to send someone to Monday's workshop. We have been interested in the development of this rule and how renewable energy sources would be defined. While MDC does not have direct regulatory authority related to the responsible management of privately-owned forests, we have broad constitutional authority in providing guidance in forestry practices and products, for both rural and urban forests.

In your definition section, clean and untreated wood is proposed. This would appear vague and confusing to MDC.

What is clean? (sawed timber, wood without bark, without glues and fasteners, without invasive pests or disease, etc.)

What is considered to be untreated wood? While many forms of chemical treatment are no longer used, some products including pallets may contain chemicals and pesticides. Many wood products, again including pallets, are increasingly using heat treatment to eliminate the presence of pests. Does this jeopardize your definition?

MDC would ask you consider adding the following to your definition. By doing so, the definition would broaden and allow a greater range of woody biomass as a renewable (or sustainable) energy source.

Proposed definition

7. Clean and untreated wood, such as pallets;[UE: clarify to include pellets][COLIN: include tree trimmings][KCPL comments]

MDC suggestion: 7. Wood, free of preservatives, metals, and pesticides, but includes pelletized wood and woody biomass derived from sustainable silivicultural practices such as timber stand thinnings and sawtimber harvest residue provided *MDC's BMPs for Woody*

Biomass Harvesting are followed. All forms of urban wood wastes and sawmill residues would be considered as renewable energy sources.
