NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1) states the following to the Commission as its *Notice of Voluntary Dismissal*:

- 1. On May 26, 2019, MAWC filed an *Application and Motion for Waivers* ("*Application*") for certificates of convenience and necessity for MAWC to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system and a sewer system in Miller County, Missouri, in a development known as Isla del Sol Condominiums. The Commission assigned two case numbers for these filings (WA-2019-0364 and SA-2019-0365), and later consolidated the two cases with Case No. WA-2019-0364 as the lead case.
- 2. To provide service to the proposed area, MAWC entered into an *Asset Purchase Agreement* to purchase the water distribution system and sewer system from Rockwood Bank (Seller). A copy of the *Asset Purchase Agreement* was attached to the *Application* as Appendix D-C.

- 3. On September 16, 2019, the Commission received an ex parte contact that called into question the ownership of the assets subject to the *Asset Purchase Agreement*. The Commission issued a *Notice of Ex Parte Contact* and directed MAWC and the Commission's Staff to file suggestions on the status of MAWC's *Application*. On September 26, 2019, MAWC and the Staff filed responses stating the ownership of the assets that are the subject of MAWC's *Application* are at issue¹ and agreeing the Commission should stay its proceedings.
- 4. On September 27, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Staying Proceedings* directing MAWC to file a status report no later than November 1, 2019, and on the first of each month thereafter.
- 5. On June 5, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Amending Status Report Schedule*, wherein it directed that MAWC file status reports every three months.
- 6. The asset ownership issues have not been resolved as of this date. The litigation involving the Isla del Sol Condominium Association, Inc. and Rockwood Bank continues.
- 7. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1) states that "An applicant . . . may voluntarily dismiss an application . . . without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties." Prepared testimony has not been filed, nor oral evidence offered, in this case. Accordingly, MAWC hereby provides its *Notice of Voluntary Dismissal*.

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully requests that the Commission recognize this *Notice of Voluntary Dismissal* without prejudice pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1).
