**MOTION TO APPROVE THE STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT AND
DISMISS FOR GOOD CAUSE**

COMES NOW the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program (“Director”) of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through undersigned counsel, for its *Motion to Approve the Stipulation and Agreement and Dismiss for Good Cause*, respectfully states as follows:

1. On January 7, 2016, the Director and Champion Home Builders, Inc. (“Champion”), filed a *Stipulation and Agreement* for the Commission’s consideration and approval to resolve all issues identified by the Director’s complaint in File No. MC-2016-0021.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the *Stipulation and Agreement*, the Director would dismiss the complaint upon presentation of a release signed by the homeowner(s) which outlined the terms set forth in Paragraph 1 of the *Stipulation and Agreement*.

3. On January 6, 2016, the Director received a copy of an executed waiver between Champion and the homeowners in accordance with the terms set forth in Paragraph 1 of the *Stipulation and Agreement*.

4. The Director notes that no prepared testimony has been filed and no oral evidence has been offered. 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) would permit voluntary dismissal of this Complaint without an order of the Commission. However, 4 CSR 240-2.116(4) also permits dismissal of the complaint for good cause found by the Commission. Good cause exists to dismiss the Complaint because Complainants are satisfied with the resolution outlined above. Therefore, the Signatories seek an order from the Commission dismissing the Complaint for good cause as the terms of the *Stipulation and Agreement* have been satisfied.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully request approving the Stipulation and Agreement filed on January 7, 2016, and issue an order from the Commission dismissing this Complaint for good cause as the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement have been satisfied.
